

# Story Workshop to build fair stories

From our first inquiry unit: Who We Are, we explore how to develop an inclusive community where our abilities and diversity make-up our global perspectives. Being fair is part of participating as a balanced learner in our communities. To revisit this concept, we read the book "Fair Shares" and we remember how not everyone needs the same.



Some children were not familiar with pears, so the next day, we brought this fruit and we explored more about it through our senses. Next, we played a chair game building collaboration.
